ENVIRONMENTAL STUDY REPORT**

The Township of The Archipelago has studied improvements to South Shore Road (formerly known as Highway 644) and to municipal facilities in the community of Pointe au Baril. Improvements to South Shore Road are proposed from Highway 69 to the Pointe au Baril Community Centre. Also planned are improvements to the Pointe au Baril municipal wharf and the construction of a municipal waterfront park.

This study has been completed under Schedule C of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) process. This is a Notice that the Environmental Study Report is being placed in the public record for review. Subject to comments received as a result of this Notice and the receipt of necessary approvals, the Township may proceed with the construction of this project.
